You have been Court Ordered to complete a class and/or complete community service a condition of your deferral or as a result of your conviction. You must return to Court a certificate of completion from a State Approved Provider as directed by the Court.

If you do not return this proof to the Court as directed, your driver's license or driving privileges shall be suspended for a time period up to 6 months. Please review the following information as it applies to your case:

### ALCOHOL AWARENESS COURSE INFORMATION

You shall complete an alcohol awareness program approved by the Department of State Health Services or a drug and alcohol driving awareness program approved by the Texas Education Agency.

### COMMUNITY SERVICE

MUST BE WITH A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT BENEFITS THE COMMUNITY. You may be required to show proof of non-profit status as defined by the IRS and the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts for the organization for which you performed community service. The Court has the right to refuse Community Service performed at an unauthorized agency. You must complete the hours in person. You cannot buy or supply products for community service in lieu of hours. The Court has attached a list of authorized community service providers. Please use our list. If you perform community service at a provider not on our list, you must receive permission from the Court BEFORE starting your community service. All paperwork must be completed as directed.

### THEFT PREVENTION

**You have a choice of class providers.** You may complete the course online at a State Approved website for a Theft Prevention Class. The Texas Theft Awareness Class must be at least 4 hours.
