You have been Court Ordered to complete an alcohol awareness course and complete community service OR any other class as a condition of your deferral. You must return to Court a certificate of completion from a State Approved Provider by the end of your deferral period.

If you do not return this proof to the Court by the end of your deferral period, your driver's license or driving privileges can be suspended for any time period up to 6 months.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

MUST BE WITH A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT BENEFITS THE COMMUNITY. You may be required to show proof of non-profit status as defined by the IRS and the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts for the organization for which you performed community service. The Court has the right to refuse Community Service performed at an unauthorized agency. You must complete the hours in person. You cannot buy or supply products for community service in lieu of hours.
